The Black Belt Golf Academy has been designed specifically to offer a year round intense instructional program for our beginner junior golfers at Indian Creek. It is intended to develop our young junior golfers ability, knowledge, rules, etiquette and both on and off-course behavior.

The “Black Belt Junior Golf Program” is used as a platform for improvement very similar to that of martial arts. Graduation to the “competition” level of the academy is the ultimate goal. This program will utilize the original “colored hat system” that Bruce developed through his knowledge of martial arts to measure progress and growth through the program. The most intense part of the program is offered in the summer months of June, July and August.

Beginner Class: (4:30 to 5:30 during weekday practices (varies each week) and 1:00-2:30 on Saturday) Children all ages that are just beginning the game.

All Pricing includes \$35/month “Junior Academy Benefit” fee

- Range balls...up to 3 buckets per day
- Daily play after school during Weekdays (some parental supervision required)
- After 1 pm on Weekends (availability based)
- Outside of ‘Academy Benefit’ hours: \$5/round on Lakes; \$10/round on Creek

Fee Structure:

\$155 per month for 1 day per week (weekday class only)

\$195 per month for Saturday only

\$260 per month for 2 days per week
